

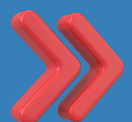

GUIDELINES

Write on any topic related to one of the following areas:

- ✔ A particular topic of global current affairs
- ✔ A topic related to origin, customs valuation, or tariff classification of goods
- ✔ A new national or regional customs framework
- ✔ A novel event or circumstance on economic integration





STYLE AND FORMATTING

- 1. Word processor: Word**
- 2. Maximum length: 8 pages**
- 3. Format: Arial, 11-point font, 1.15 line spacing, no page numbering, no margin titles**
- 4. Graphs and images: include within the body of the text**
- 5. Citations and references: place at the end of the text according to bibliography and page number**
- 6. Text division and ordering: Dewey system (1.1. 1.2.1. 1.2.1.1)**
- 7. Bibliography: author (last name, first name); book title; edition; publisher; city and year. For citations and/or references to websites, the link and the date of last access must be indicated.**
- 8. Personal reference or author's bio: must be five lines long and no more than 240 characters**
- 9. La fotografía del autor (opcional) deberá enviarse en archivo por separado**
- 10. Logos or commercial/professional references must NOT be included**
- 11. Graphs and images may be included if strictly necessary, particularly in materials related to tariff classification**
- 12. Language: the article must be submitted in both Spanish and English.**

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
